COLORADO The U.S. Air Force Academy has awarded a \$27.8-million contract to GE Johnson Construction Co. for phases seven and eight of the renovation of **Vandenberg Hall**, a dorm on the Colorado Springs campus. The project entails plumbing and fire-suppression systems upgrades, category-five cable wiring, replacement of the existing curtain wall, new and refurbished HVAC systems, and new electrical power systems and lighting. NEW HAMPSHIRE Berlin Station LLC has awarded \$205 million in contracts to the Babcock & Wilcox Co. to build and maintain Berlin Station, a **biomass powerplant** in Berlin. The project entails building a 75-MW plant, which will burn 750,000 tons of wood chips and logging waste a year. The plant will be built on a site previously owned by the Fraser paper mill, which closed in 2006. The job includes converting a Babcock & Wilcox (B&W) boiler, ensconced in the mill in 1993, and installing a bubbling fluid-bed boiler. Berlin Station LLC has awarded B&W's construction division, Babcock & Wilcox Construction Co. Inc., a \$186-million contract to engineer, procure and construct the facility. Berlin Station also signed a \$19-million contract with Delta Power Services LLC, a B&W company, to operate and maintain the plant. Public Service of New Hampshire has secured a 20-year power purchase agreement to buy the electricity generated at Berlin Station. **Babcock & Wilcox Construction Co. TEXAS North Park Lincoln Mercury has awarded a contract to Bartlett Cocke General Contractors to build **North Park Volkswagen**. The project entails building a 26,697-sq-ft building at the intersection of Interstate 10 and Oak Drive in San Antonio. The project is expected to be com-

NORTH CAROLINA 11/2 JE Dunn Construction, the construction manager, is seeking subcontractor bids to build the **Health Pavilion Hoke** in Raeford. The project includes three buildings: a two-story, 56,000-sq-ft outpatient center, a three-story, 51,000-sq-ft medical office building and a two-story, 15,000-sq-ft central energy plant. NEW MEXICO 11/4 The City of Las Vegas is seeking proposals for the **Peterson Dam** rehabilitation and reservoir enlargement. Peterson Dam is a 210-ft-long, 50-ft-high concrete arch dam, built in 1911. It is being rehabilitated to meet state dam safety regulations as well as increase municipal water storage capacity. The preferred solution entails raising the dam height 49 feet using roller-compacted concrete (RCC), an approach that will enable the reservoir to store an additional 1,204 acre-ft. The proposed construction will reinforce the existing dam, which is deteriorating due to freeze and thaw cycles and seepage penetrating through the dam and its abutments. The proposed dam extension will partially encapsulate existing

seepage and reroute any remaining seepage through an internal drainage system. The project is valued at \$16.2 million. RHODE ISLAND 11/8 The Narragansett Bay Commission is seeking bidders to build the **Woonasquatucket Combined Sewer Overflow Interceptor**. The project comprises pipelines, tunnels, shafts and ancillary facilities, utility relocations and temporary combined sewer-overflow bypass facilities. The interceptor will be 19,150 ft long.
